## **BLAZING A NEW PATH**

An exciting new chapter began on Saturday, February 24, as Blaze Credit Union celebrated its first Annual Meeting and Member Appreciation Day at Grace Church in Eden Prairie. Over 3,700 Blazers joined in on the fun-attending educational seminars, visiting the Blaze Expo, taking photos with our mascot team: Cash, Nordy, Mudonna, and TC Bear, adding a new Blaze t-shirt to their wardrobe, and everyone received \$25 cash upon leaving. Attendees also donated 1,600 pounds of food to benefit People Reaching Out to People (PROP) Food Shelf.

The event began with a recognition of our military featuring Blaze board member, Sergeant Len Leitner, and the singing of "The Star-Spangled Banner" by John deCausmeaker, official National Anthem singer for the Minnesota Wild. Blaze CEO, Dan Stoltz, welcomed all attendees to this historic event and shared Blaze's Core Purpose: Better Lives. The Core Value of being Thoughtfully Compassionate, the Core Vision to be Minnesota's Best, and the Core Action to Give Back.

Stoltz also presented new Blaze testimonials featuring Blaze's many new partners, including Basketball Hall of Famer, Lindsay Whalen, who was in attendance.

## KEEP YOUR ONLINE DEVICES SECURE

Most people use their computer and/ or mobile device to conduct business, send emails, make purchases online and store their personal information. This information could range from your bank account number, credit or debit card numbers, tax returns, etc. These online devices are at risk of being compromised so it's best to treat them like a digital safe.

Here are some tips on how to keep your devices secure:

- Make sure your device is password protected. If you lose it, your personal information is up for grabs to anyone who finds it unless it's password protected.
- NEVER allow someone to connect or remote access into your phone or computer. Scammers pretend to be trusted companies to trick you into allowing access or downloading an app so they can steal your personal data and financial information. Allowing remote access provides the scammer access to anything you have on your device.
- Keep your device's software and security up to date. Anti-virus/ anti-malware scans help prevent unwanted access into your device.
- If you think there may be a virus or unwanted software on your device, consult with someone you trust and/ or take it to a business that offers in person technical support.
